

## **‘Summing up’ characteristic features of a poet**

<p><b>Verse form</b> <i>(e.g. ballad, epic, monologue)</i></p>	
<p><b>Structure</b> <i>(e.g. parts, stanzas; relationship between beginning, middle and end; time)</i></p>	
<p><b>Voice</b> <i>(e.g. narrative voice, voices of characters, dialogue)</i></p>	
<p><b>Poetic techniques</b> <i>(Rhyme; Rhythm; Repetition; Refrain; Sound effects e.g. alliteration, onomatopoeia, assonance; Imagery or symbolism; Other figurative language e.g. hyperbole, bathos, apostrophe etc)</i></p>	
<p><b>Poem’s emphasis</b> <i>(e.g. the characters; the story; the setting; the mood; dialogue; the narrator and subtleties of narrative voice; the themes; the message or moral of the poem)</i></p>
